



Embellished Swarovski Crystal Bracelet

Project Description

Take the simple Swarovski Crystal Bracelet to the next level and make the design your own. Add a bunch of embellishments, just a little or no embellishment at all. Learn some simple techniques to speed up making the bracelet base.

Prerequisite

This tutorial assumes that you have completed the *Swarovski Crystal Bracelet* tutorial (which is available wherever you purchased this tutorial).

Materials

- ❖ Swarovski Crystal Bracelet tutorial
 - ♦ By Pam Preslar, available on this site
- ❖ The Embellished Crystal Bracelet sample in 6mm
 - ♦ 68 - 6mm bicone Swarovski Crystals
 - ♦ 14mm button with shank
 - ♦ Size 11 seed beads
- ❖ The Embellished Crystal Bracelet sample in 4mm
 - ♦ 100 - 4mm bicone Swarovski Crystals
 - ♦ 12mm button with shank
 - ♦ Size 11 or 15 seed beads
- ❖ Nymo size D thread in a coordinating color.
- ❖ Substitutions
 - ♦ You can use any size of base bead. I have made these in all sizes from 3mm to 8mm. I use size 15 seed beads with 3mm and 4mm crystals.
 - ♦ Any bicone shape works well, it doesn't have to be Swarovski. Swarovski is just my personal preference. 3 and 4mm Czech fire polish beads (faceted round glass) and druks (round pressed Czech glass) also look great.



Tools

- ❖ Size 10 or 12 beading needles.
 - ♦ Note: you will want the thinner size 12 needles if you are using 4mm crystals or smaller.
 - ❖ Fine scissors or other thread cutting tool.
 - ❖ A bead mat or anything to keep your beads from rolling away while you work.
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
