



Beads and Other Supplies

Materials

- ❖ Swarovski Crystal Bracelet tutorial (optional)
 - ♦ By Pam Preslar, available free on this site
 - ♦ This is helpful but not required. It contains lots of great information and tips on right angle weave. You will use much of this information in this tutorial.
- ❖ The Crown Neckpiece
 - ♦ 370 - 4mm bicone beads for 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (about 42cm). This is about 21 beads per inch.
 - 45 of those can be of your accent color
 - ♦ Size 11° or 15° seed beads
 - ♦ 15mm button with shank or alternative clasp
 - ♦ Nymo size D thread in a coordinating color.
- ❖ The Crown Bracelet
 - ♦ 140 - 4 mm bicone beads for a 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bracelet. (about 18cm)
 - 14 of those can be of your accent color
 - ♦ Size 11° or 15° seed beads
 - ♦ 15mm button with shank or alternative clasp
 - ♦ Nymo size D thread in a coordinating color.

I recommend
Swarovski or
Preciosa crystals.

Tools

- ❖ Size 10 or 12 beading needles.
 - ♦ Note: I usually start with a 10 but switch to 12 when the bead holes become too full of thread to get through easily.
- ❖ Fine scissors or other thread cutting tool.
- ❖ A bead mat or anything to keep your beads from rolling away while you work.

Figure 1 is a Crown Bracelet with a toggle clasp from my *Woven Toggle Clasp* tutorial. This clasp is also covered in my *Beads, Buttons & Baubles* tutorial.
